INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- There is no quilt exhibitor entry fee.
- The quilt <u>must</u> have been completed after 2019.
- The Shasta Lily Quilt Show 2024 label <u>must</u> be basted to the back of the quilt in the lower right-hand corner (as you face the back of the quilt).
- Each quilt <u>must</u> have a 4" sleeve sewn to the top of the quilt back (no pins). A 2" sleeve is adequate for a quilt with a perimeter measuring less than 120". Quilted items that do not hang will not need a sleeve.
- When you deliver your quilt, you will receive a numbered receipt for each quilt. No quilt will be released without its corresponding receipt.
- Shasta Lily Quilt Guild will make every effort to provide security for your quilt(s). However, insurance on your quilt(s) is your responsibility. Shasta Lily Quilt Guild is not responsible for any damage or loss of any entry.
- We will make every effort to accommodate all entries. Should the number of entries exceed our capacity, entries will be given space according to the date the entry form was submitted.
- Attach a photo of the quilt to the entry form. Those entries that are e-mailed can attach a photo of the quilt to the email.
- Viewers' Choice Ribbons will be awarded at 2:00 PM on Sunday.
- Quilts <u>must</u> be dropped off on Wednesday, August 21, 2024, between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. If you are unable to drop off your entry(s) at that time, please make arrangements with friends or family to have them drop off your entry(s).
- Quilts <u>must</u> be picked up on Sunday, September 1, 2024, between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. If you are unable to pick up your entry(s) at that time, please make arrangements with friends or family to have them pick up your entry(s). They will need the corresponding receipt(s) to pick up your entry(s).
- Category descriptions are on the reverse; please read them carefully.

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Hand Quilted Quilt A quilt that has been hand quilted in its entirety. All other construction may be completed by hand or machine.
- Hand Appliqué Quilt A quilt that utilizes hand appliqué as its design focus. May include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders. Appliqué must be hand stitched. All other construction may be completed by hand or machine.
- Machine Appliqué Quilt A quilt that utilizes appliqué secured by a machine as its design focus. May
 include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders. Appliqué may be raw-edge or turned. All other construction
 may be completed by hand or machine.
- Hand Embroidered Quilt A quilt that utilizes hand embroidery as its design focus. May include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders. Embroidery must be hand stitched. All other construction may be completed by hand or machine.
- Machine Embroidered Quilt A quilt that utilizes machine embroidery as its design focus. May include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders. Embroidery must be machine stitched. All other construction may be completed by hand or machine.
- Vintage Quilt A quilt constructed from unfinished vintage quilt top/blocks. Top/blocks must have been constructed prior to 1980. The finished quilt must have been completed after 2019.
- Miniature Quilt A quilt that is a scaled-down version of a full-sized pattern with a maximum perimeter of 96". No one size is larger than 24". Cannot be a single block with a border.
- Traditional Pieced Quilt A quilt that is constructed using regularly repeating shapes, typically based on a grid. A quilt that is constructed using traditionally established techniques, patterns, and design principles.
- Modern Quilt A quilt that is inspired by modern design and innovation and utilizes bold color, high contrast, improvisational piecing, minimalism, maximalism, expansive negative space, alternate grid work, and modern traditionalism.
- Art Quilt A non-traditional quilt that is an <u>original</u> examination of a concept. A quilt that is designed to be displayed and is not necessarily practical. The design should be unique and imaginative in the use of color, theory, and technique.
- Whole-cloth Quilt A quilt that is constructed from a single piece of solid (no print) fabric and utilizes quilting as its design focus.
- Panel Quilt A quilt that utilizes a printed panel as its design focus. May include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders.
- **T-Shirt Quilt** A quilt largely constructed from t-shirts. May include pieced blocks, sashing, and borders.
- Quilted Item An item that is quilted but is not a quilt, such as bags, totes, purses, toys, bibs, clothing, shoes, pillows, pillow covers, tablecloths, table runners, placemats, potholders, coasters, cozy's, and ornaments.
